

About the *Voices of Naples* Vocal Music Scholarship

Over the past 21 years, *Voices of Naples* has awarded \$54,500 in scholarships.

Once again, *Voices of Naples* is offering scholarship awards in vocal music to graduating seniors from Collier and Lee Counties who plan to pursue a college major associated with vocal music. The award is intended to encourage the student to continue the study of vocal music at a college or university. Scholarship recipients may also have the opportunity to reapply for a continuing scholarship.

Established in 2002, *Voices of Naples* is a community chorus organized as a Florida not-for-profit corporation and designated as a 501©(3) charitable organization. The group consists of a paid musical director, board of directors, and approximately seventy-five volunteer singers of all ages. The members are selected by referral and audition. Performance venues have primarily been at local churches, and repertoire ranges from classical to jazz, with divisi from two to twelve parts.

The mission of *Voices of Naples* is the following:

- to present a gift of quality choral music to the community that is uplifting to the audience and the choral ensemble,

- to provide an opportunity for singers to learn choral techniques and to study various types of choral literature,

- to provide scholarship opportunities for student vocalists, and

- to provide opportunities for the choral ensemble to perform in concert.

Voices of Naples rehearses from mid-October through early April. Annually, in November, the group hosts a "Sing-Along" *Messiah*, using chamber orchestra and professional soloists. Also, *Voices* presents at least two spring concerts in the February/March time-frame. Scholarship winners are encouraged to perform at our spring concerts. Our March 3, 2024 concert will be held at Naples United Church of Christ in Naples, FL beginning at 3:00 p.m..

Auditions will be held on the evening of **Monday, April 8, 2024** at First Presbyterian Church, 250 6th Street South, Naples, FL, starting at 6pm in the second floor Choir Room. If you already have a prior commitment scheduled for this date, please notify us ahead of time. You will be notified of your audition time by **March 25, 2024**. Please prepare the following for your audition:

one art song of a classical genre,

one piece of any genre of your choosing.

We recommend that you choose pieces which will illustrate your vocal ability regarding technique, range, and expression. At least one of your selections must be in English, and both must be memorized.

You are responsible for your own accompaniment. You may either bring an accompanist with you or provide your own equipment for your pre-recorded accompaniment. Please note, also, that any teachers, friends, or parents who may come with you will be asked to wait outside the performance area.
